Collaboration
<p>Responsibility for Oneself:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Complete tasks on time• Use feedback to improve his or her work• Do what he or she is supposed to do without being reminded• Prepare and be ready to work with the team; be available for meetings <p>Helping the TEAM:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Help the team solve problems, manage conflicts, and stay focused and organized• Share ideas that help the team improve its work• Give useful feedback (specific and supportive) to others so they can improve their work• Offer help to peers to assist in their work <p>Respect Others:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Listen carefully to teammates• Be polite and kind to teammates

- Discuss important things to consider when collaborating

Demonstrate w/Activity

- Put students into groups of 4-5 students
- Give each group one piece of paper and tell them that they must collaborate to list as many things as possible that they ALL have in common
- The goal is to collaborate in order to complete the task
